

# Preparing teams for real emergencies

A compact 3-hour outdoor format for companies:  
Are you and your team prepared when quick action is required?

**A different kind of company outing makes it possible!**

## Event Content:

### 1) Introduction & Objectives

Warm-up, clarification of roles, objectives and rules

### 2) Introduction to the Model & Risk Basics

Short input on the model and risk factors

### 3) Practical Core: Crisis Simulation at the Demonstration Model

Self-organised employee teams jointly manage a flooding scenario with unexpected escalations.

The focus is on communication, coordination, prioritisation and decision-making under time pressure.

### 4) Debriefing & Transfer into Everyday Work

Reflection: What worked well, what did not?

**Outcome:** Three team rules that can be applied in everyday work from the very next day.

## Experts:

### Dr. Wolfgang Prügler

**(Moderation & Team-Resilience)** - Guides participants through the format, manages the simulation and evaluation, and supports the team in deriving three practical team rules.

### Dr. Natalie Prügler

**(Adaption & Prevention)** - Explains the logic of natural hazards and prevention, and translates learnings into implementable measures.

## Overview:

### Number of participants:

Ideally 10 to 20 people

**Duration:** Approx. 3 hours

### Location: Wassererlebnis Öblarn

Start: Öblarn (Railway station or main square)

## Content in Detail:

During the **3-hour BE-Ready Compact session**, teams from companies and organisations are prepared in a **highly practice-oriented** way to remain capable of **taking action under time pressure** when unexpected events occur. The clear focus is on **roles, coordination, decisions and communication**.

The format is also **suitable as a company outing with a fun factor**, where a shared experience is directly translated into concrete improvements for everyday work.

A compact theory and orientation block is included, covering **the basics of natural hazards such as heavy rainfall and flooding, escalation mechanisms such as log jams, and key principles of effective solution strategies**.

The core element is a **moderated crisis simulation** at the demonstration model. Participants organise themselves and jointly manage an event with **escalation stages**, such as flooding or triggered bottleneck situations. The goal is to quickly establish a situational picture, set **priorities**, and make important **decisions** in a transparent and efficient way.

The scenario is simulated realistically at **Wassererlebnis Oblarn** and can be **adapted** to the industry context or **typical processes** of the participating organisation. The session concludes with a structured evaluation and transfer phase.

**The outcome:** Three concrete team rules that can be applied immediately in everyday work.
